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DISPLAYS



RATIONALE/AIMS

Displays around the school are there to promote the outstanding work that goes on in our school every day. It gives the children the opportunity to share with their peers, visitors and parents what they have been doing in their classrooms. It also allows us to demonstrate our identity and culture and promote this to all stakeholders. Displays, therefore, should be put up with care and attention to promote these core values and ideals.

ALL DISPLAYS MUST:

- Have double mounted work
- Clear explanations. (double mounted)
- Every piece of work should have the child's first and last name.
- Show a range of abilities but should be the child's best effort.
- If in a corridor, show the class name.
- Be engaging and have some degree of interactivity ie questions, things for the children to do etc..
- Have some element of excitement: photos, drawings, real life objects etc.
- Have parts of the display that stand out (not everything stuck flat to the wall)
- Link back to the positive culture of the school/ British culture or SMSC
